

Privacy Policy

Introduction

This website is operated by UF VENTURES LTD (hereafter referred to as “UFV”, “Us”, “We”), a private limited liability company incorporated in Cyprus with registered number HE 440155, having its address at Nikou & Despoinas Pattichi, 37, EVI Court, 3d floor, Flat/Office 302, 3071 Limassol Cyprus.

The General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 ("GDPR"), which took effect on May 25, 2018, is one of the data privacy laws and regulations that UFV complies with while collecting, using, disclosing, and otherwise processing your Personal Data.

This Privacy Policy's main goal is to provide you with information about the data we may collect about you, how we might use it, whether we might share it with anybody, and the choices you have regarding how we use it.

As described by the GDPR, when we refer to "Personal Data" in our Privacy Policy, we mean data that relates to you and makes it possible for us to identify you, either alone or in conjunction with other data we may hold. In general, we base the processing of Personal Data that may be done so that we can fulfill our contractual obligation(s) as the publisher of this Website (hereafter "Contractual Obligation(s)") and to make us able to be in compliance with any legal obligation(s) (hereafter "Legal Obligation(s)").

We may additionally process personal data if we determine that doing so is in our best interest ("Legitimate Interest(s)") and only if we determine that your interests and rights are not more important than ours. For instance, processing certain Personal Data may be in our Legitimate Interest if it helps us develop our commercial activities (both quantitatively and qualitatively) and/or our performance as a company.

Last but not least, kindly take note that we could also need to process Personal Data in order to respond to and defend ourselves against any potential legal claims.

Personal Data we collect

Unless we believe that we may need to use the Personal Data for another purpose that is compatible with the current and original purpose, we will only use it for those purposes for which it was collected. If we decide to pursue a new purpose that is not connected to the existing ones, we agree to let you know about it and to explain why we are doing so, along with the legal justification for it.

When you use our Website, when you contact us with a question or send a request, or when you sign up for our newsletter, or when you send us any information or materials for analysis, we may get Personal Data from you.

Without being permitted to share the data with outside parties, we may use external services like Google Analytics to process data on our behalf and provide statistical and analytical services.

Your rights

In accordance with the GDPR, you have a set of rights as an individual that, in some cases, you can use in connection to the Personal Data we may hold about you. These rights include the ability to:

Request access to your Personal Data and request certain information in relation to its processing;

Request rectification of your Personal Data;

Request the erasure of your Personal Data;

Request the restriction of processing of your Personal Data;

You can revoke your consent to have your personal data processed.
